Itinerary: (This itinerary is for Thursday & Sunday departures only)

Day 01 - (Thursday or Sunday) (Lunch & dinner included)

Depart from Singapore to Guwahati by flight in the morning.

Change to a domestic flight to Pakyong and travel by a 2-hour drive to Gangtok, the capital of Sikkim.

Afternoon - Visit Tashi View Point and Tsuklakhang Royal Chapel in the Palace Compound

Evening – Shopping at MG Marg, the main marketing area of Gangtok

Day 02 - Gangtok and Dzongu (Breakfast@hotel, lunch & dinner included)

Morning – Visit to the Namgyal Institute of Tibetology and the Deorali Drol-Drul Chorten and Monastery

Afternoon – After lunch and permit formalities, depart for northern Sikkim to Dzongu (2.5hrs drive).

Dzongu is a land lies largely in the UNESCO World heritage site of mixed category.

Evening – Travel back to hotel at Dzongu.

Day 03 - Dzongu explorations (Breakfast@hotel, lunch & dinner included)

Morning – Depart for an easy hike to the monastery of Hee-Gyathang

Afternoon — Proceed to the upper regions of Dzongu. Local folklore and sights will be explained, have a

better understanding of the nature worship or 'bon' traditions of the people in this region.

Evening – Enjoy the evening Bonfire and a round of drinks – local Millet!

Day 04 - Dzongu explorations and Drive to Rabong (Breakfast@hotel, lunch & dinner included)

Morning – Arrive at a sulphur hot spring, lunch at the site after hot spring dips.

Afternoon – Long drive to lower climes to the south of Sikkim, stops at Rabong. (6-hr drive)

Visit to the beautiful Organic Tea Gardens and the jungle lodge.

Evening – Back to hotel in Rabong and rest.

Day 05 - Rabong explorations (Breakfast@hotel, lunch & dinner included)

Morning — Visit the Buddha Park, a lovely landscaped park home to the statue of Buddha Shakyamuni.

Afternoon – Visit Samdruptse Hill Namchi, Bon Monastery and Doling Monastry.

Day 06 - Rabong to Pakyong (Gauwahati) (Breakfast@hotel, lunch & dinner included)

Morning – After breakfast, drive to Pakyong and board plane to Gauwahati. Check in hotel for lunch.

Evening — City tour of Gauwahati and the local Buddhist community.

Day 07 – Gauwahati to Singapore (Breakfast@hotel included)

Morning – Heading back to Singapore
